



IDASH Pedigree Service

The IDASH Pedigree Service is available by subscription for \$20US per year. Subscribers will have access to available pedigree data on over 100,000 dogs from the US, Canada, Europe and elsewhere. This service was built upon the foundation set by Patrick MacRoberts with the public pedigree database he created and maintained for many years.

Each dog's record includes its name and additional information to the extent available:

- Parents
- Titles
- Gender
- Dates of birth/death
- Registration number(s)
- Coat color
- 10-generation coefficient of inbreeding (COI)

Viewable reports include:

Standard Pedigree – Users may select the number of generations they wish to view (3-8). Dogs whose names appear multiple times will be color coded.

Breeding Report – a listing of all known litters produced by the dog and the mate with which each litter was produced.

Sibling Report – lists all full and half siblings of the dog. Half-sibling listings name the shared and other parent.

Vertical Pedigree – may be selected for number of generations (3-8). Each ancestor has a list of its full and half siblings.

Reverse Pedigree – lists the dog's descendants; number of generations (3-8) may be selected.

Trial Pedigree – allows the user to create a pedigree by selecting the parents. Due to computing capacity limitations this feature may be confined to dogs likely to be alive at this time.

Downloadable pedigrees – users may download a 1-page 4-generation pedigree in pdf format for any dog in the database.

Health Pedigree - this new report created by ASHGI will allow the user to click through to the Open Health Database page for each dog in the pedigree for easy tracking of health information.
