



## International Directory for Australian Shepherd Health

ASHGI established IDASH to provide breeders and owners with specific pedigree-based health information and to enable breeders to make more informed breeding decisions as regards health and unwanted inherited traits in the Australian Shepherd through its Open Health Database, Pedigree Analysis Service and Pedigree Service (in development).

IDASH resources include

- One of the few comprehensive single-breed open health databases anywhere
- Health data on over 40,000 dogs
- A broad collection of health and genetic data covering almost five dozen different inherited traits, including coat color, dental faults, disqualifying colors, and diseases
- Offers a comprehensive pedigree analysis program with reports offering a 10-generation COI and risk scores for 26 different traits.
- (Available soon) An international web-mounted and publicly accessible pedigree database including over 100K dogs from at least 20 countries
